The West Bengal Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as the State Board) hereby grants Consent to Establish (CTE) from environmental point under Section 25 & 26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, as amended and Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended and rules and orders made thereunder for proposed new unit of AAKANKSHA FOUNDATION at Ritwik Ghatak Bithi, Sail Co-Operative, P.O.- City Centre, P.S. - Durgapur, Dist.- Paschim Bardhaman, PIN-713216, C. S. Dag No.- 3603, J.L. No.- 74, K.H. No.- 687, Mouza- Faridpur for the following activities

(A) General Conditions:

- (1) The quality of sewage and industrial effluent to be discharged from the factory shall satisfy the permissible limits as per norms and Environment (Protection) Rules 1986.
- (2) The unit shall apply to the State Board for Consent to operate according to the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended and the Air (Prevention & Control Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended prior to commencement of activities of the unit.
- (3) The unit shall comply with the following Environmental Acts and Rules and its amendment as applicable
 - (i) The Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.
 - (ii) The Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981
 - (iii) The Environment (Protection) Act, 1986
 - (iv) The Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991
 - (v) The Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989
 - (vi) The Ozone Depleting Substances (Regulation and Control) Rules, 2000
 - (vii) The Batteries (Management and Handling) Rules, 2022
 - (viii) The Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules, 2000
 - (ix) The Bio-medical Wastes Management Rules, 2016
 - (x) The Hazardous Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016
 - (xi) The Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016

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- (xii) The Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016
- (xiii) The E-Waste (Management Rules), 2022
- (xiv) The Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016
- (4) The State Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke etc. this consent for establishment and the same shall be binding on the unit.
- (5) The unit shall obtain permission/clearance from the other competent authorities, as applicable and such permissions may be required at the time of submitting application for Consent to operate.
- (6) The unit shall abide by the stipulations as may be prescribed by any authority / local body / government departments etc.
- (7) Suitable measures to treat the effluent and emission shall be adopted in order to reduce the pollution load so that the quality of the effluent and emission from the unit always conforms to the relevant permissible standards.
- (8) No equipment/machinery, emission and effluent generation/discharge source etc. shall be installed/modified without prior approval of the State Board.

(B) Special Conditions:

- A) Emission:- Nil.
- B) Effluent:-
- 1) Process/Wash- Treatment and disposal of liquid waste should be carried out in accordance with the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974(6 of 1974).
 - 2) Domestic– to be discharged through septic tank to Municipal drain.
- C) Bio-Medical Waste:-To be disposed off as per provisions of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and it's subsequent amendments.
- D) Solid Waste:- To be disposed off regularly in arrangement with local authority.
- E) General:-
- 1) Noise Control-Ambient noise level not to exceed the permissible limit.
- 2) Good house-keeping of the unit to be maintained.
- 3) Tree planting-adequate greenery to be developed within the premises of the unit.
- 4) All types of precautionary measures to be taken for prevention of fire hazard including obtaining necessary clearance from appropriate authority.
- 5) Clinical licenses to be obtained from appropriate authority for establishment of the unit.
- 6) The unit should arrange for segregation, treatment and disposal of Bio-Medical Waste as per provisions of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 7) No additional machinery/ equipment can be installed without prior permission from this Board.
- 8) This NOC may be revoked in case of any valid public complaint against the unit from environmental point of view.
- 9) Land Conversion certificate to be obtained from concerned authority.
- 10) Consent to Operate and Bio-Medical Waste Authorization have to be obtained from WBPCB for operating the unit.
- 11) The unit should use non-chlorinated plastic bags for collection of bio-medical wastes as per the Bio- medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and its amendments.
- 12) The unit should use at least 120 micron thick plastic bags as per the Plastic waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2021. Extended Producer's Responsibility (EPR) registration should be obtained by the unit through online portal 'https://eprplastic.cpcb.gov.in'.

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Any Violation of the aforesaid Conditions shall entail cancellation of this Consent to Establish
